

## Letter of Understanding Concerning BYODs – From Year 5/CM1 Students and Ecole Française Internationale Auckland Agreement

**I/We understand** that I am allowed to bring a personal computing device, preferably Chromebook, to school as part of the school's BYOD programme from Year 5 / CM1.

**I/We agree** that I will use the personal computing device for learning inside and outside of the classroom with the care required as part of the Cyber Safety Contract.

**I/We understand and agree** that I will not do anything on the device or use the device in any way that will bring École Francaise Internationale Auckland into disrepute through e-mails, group chats, texts, tweets, videos, pictures or any other such manner.

**I/We understand** that I am totally responsible for my device while at school. This includes its insurance, its care and looking after its peripherals such as chargers. The device needs to be fully charged **before arriving at school**. I undertake to purchase some sort of covering that will protect the device.

**I/We understand** that I will be responsible for putting the device in the lockable storage area provided in the classroom.

**I/We will provide** the serial number of the device for monitoring purposes by the school.

**I/We will surrender** the device upon request by the teacher or IT facilitator for checking of misuse e.g. use at inappropriate times when not directed by a teacher

I/We understand that all maintenance, updates and repairs are to be undertaken by me / us at my / our expense.

I/We will be responsible for transporting my device to and from school.

I/We understand that École Française Internationale Auckland will provide access to the Internet via its network.

I/We will abide by all cyber-safety rules as outlined in the school Cyber Safety Policy.

**I/We also understand** that École Francaise Internationale Auckland reserves the right to withdraw permission for me to have my device at school should any of the above conditions be breached.

## **Cyber Safety Contract**

Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs) include computers (networked or stand alone) and all their associated applications, the Internet, mobile telephones, digital cameras, photocopiers, scanners, audio and video devices.

- 1. I accept that the use of ICTs is for educational purposes.
- 2. I will not use the Internet without first requesting permission to do so from the teacher responsible for me at that time.
- 3. I will identify myself in all correspondence by using my first name only.
- 4. I will not reveal any personal details, my own or other people's.
- 5. I will respect the rights, privacy and property of others. This includes their passwords and files.
- 6. I agree not to access or search for unsuitable, offensive, or illegal material.
- 7. I will notify my teacher if I encounter material which I know to be of a doubtful or unacceptable nature.
- 8. I understand that I am not to use web based email accounts (other than my school allocated one) or web based instant messaging programmes.
- 9. I will respect the school's equipment and resources and report damage to a teacher.
- 10. I agree not to download any files from the network, or Internet, and will not install any software onto the school's computers.
- 11. In all my communications I will be courteous and use appropriate language.
- 12. I will respect copyright and acknowledge the source of my research material.
- 13. I understand that usage of the Internet is monitored and reviewed, and records kept of this usage.
- 14. If a student brings a personal digital device/cellphone to our school, the following guidelines apply;
  - the school does not accept responsibility for lost, damaged, or stolen personal devices brought to the school but investigates any issues as appropriate.
  - The cell phone should be turned off and handed to the classroom teacher at the beginning of the day, placed in a locked box and returned to the student at the end of the day.
- 15. I understand that inappropriate use of ICTs will result in disciplinary action.
