TUITION FEES

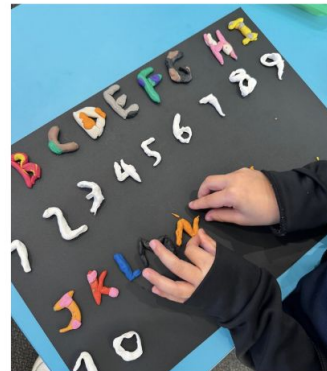
Per year: \$14,000

The School Day

- Learners attend school from 8:30 am – 3 pm, Monday to Friday
